Sacramental Preparation at St John's

Dear Parent/Carer

St John the Evangelist Catholic High School is able to offer preparatory courses for the reception of the Sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation (Confession), Eucharist (First Holy Communion) and Confirmation for students who have not received these Sacraments and would like to do so.

These preparatory courses will be conducted at St John's High School commencing early in the 2020 school year for one period a week, during class time. The preparation for each of the Sacraments should take approximately five weeks.

Students being prepared for the Sacraments will be withdrawn from their normal lessons and will be expected to catch up on missed work in their own time. In addition, there may be a small task and reflection on the Sacraments to be completed by the following week.

It is anticipated that students who have undergone the necessary preparation will receive these Sacraments at one of the St Michael's Parish Churches. It is anticipated that students who are preparing for their First Reconciliation will receive this sacrament at school in the chapel.
