The student must read the exam timetable carefully before the examination period and report any concerns immediately to the Curriculum Coordinator.

Mobile telephones, electronic devices or smart watches are NOT PERMITTED in the examination room. Similarly, they are **NOT** to be in students' pockets. They **must be signed in** with the Curriculum Office. Only essential equipment may be brought into the exam room. It is the student's responsibility for the security of their phones and electronic devices; they may be best left at home. Breach of this rule **will result in an entry on the Malpractice Register**.

Students **must write in black pen** unless otherwise directed. All pens and other equipment must be in a see through container. Students should also bring their Compass Card. Bags are not permitted in the examination room. Students who need to attend the bathroom during an exam **MUST** be accompanied by a supervisor and the supervisor must wait outside the bathroom and accompany the student back to the exam room.

With the exception of water in a clear bottle, no food or drink is permitted in the exam room.

At the commencement of the exam students must follow instructions as directed by the supervisor.

For each course, students are to enter the room alphabetically in silence and remain silent for the entirety of the exam session.

In reading time, students should check that they have all sections of the paper. If there are any issues, the student is to raise their hand to inform the supervisor.

No student is to commence writing until directed by the supervisor. **Exams must be completed in silence**. There is to be no form of communication between students in the exam room. Any non-verbal, verbal or physical communication may result in **an entry on the Malpractice Register**. If you need to contact a supervisor, you must raise your hand and wait silently.

A clock will be at the front of the exam room for students to monitor their time. No warning times will be issued by the supervisor.

Any form of disruptive behaviour or behaviour suggestive of cheating may result in an N Warning for that subject. Any form of cheating will result in **an entry on the Malpractice Register**.

No student is to leave an exam prior to the finish time of the exam.

At the conclusion of the examination follow instructions as directed by the supervisor. Students must immediately cease writing on the direction 'Pens Down, this exam has now finished'.

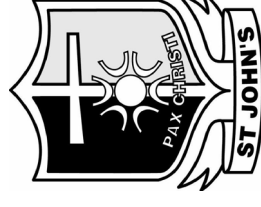
No form of communication, verbal or non-verbal is permitted during this time. Students must remain in complete silence until they have left the examination area.

Exams will be collected in one bundle, not sections. Students must check that they have written their student number on each section of the paper. If you have not written your student number on every section, raise your hand and ask the supervisor if you may do so, otherwise it will be viewed as cheating. You must hand in every section of the exam paper, even if you have not answered a section, you must write your student number on the paper and it is to be collected with all other sections.

No student is to leave the room before all papers are collected and a check is completed that all work has been handed in. No papers are to be taken from the exam room.

If a student is late for an exam, they must immediately notify the school by phone. You will sit the exam on your arrival, but will not be permitted any extra time. You may submit a misadventure form if there is good reason as to why you were late. *This does not include misreading the timetable, missing the bus or sleeping in.*

Illness or issues in an exam must be reported to the exam supervisor. The student must notify the Leader of Learning or office and apply for misadventure immediately after the exam concludes.

2025 Yearly Exam Timetable

Commencing 5 September 2025

- There is **NO flexible attendance on Friday 5 September**. Students must attend school, including students in English Studies.
- There is **NO flexible attendance on Friday 12 September**. Students must attend school.
- All classes recommence on **Monday 15 September 2025**.
- Between 8 and 11 September, students have flexible attendance when there is no scheduled exam.
- If students have two exams on the one day, they are **NOT** to leave the school grounds between exams.
- If a student is at school outside of a scheduled exam, they must sign in/out at **the nominated study room/s**, except for scheduled recess and lunch breaks. Students must sign out of the study room when they leave (unless they are going straight to an exam).
- If a student is leaving the school grounds at the end of an exam during the school day, the student does not need to sign out.
- Students are to wear full school uniform to each exam, jerseys are permitted.
- Assessment procedures and rules apply for all exams.
- **Disability provisions: Students with approved disability provisions are to report to Mrs Chapman in the Diverse Learning Hub at 8.25am for morning exams and 12.15pm for afternoon exams.**
