James presented a slide show (see attachments)

- Strategic improvement plan
- 2025 focus
 - o priorities are growth and achievement outcomes
 - Limiting stage 6 extra-curricular events for both students and teachers so that can have a focus on their learning
- Tell them from me survey's have gone out for community consult this allows the school to know if they are on track
- A1&A2 awning landscaping and static equipment completed
- Undercover cola tiered seating school has engaged with a team to do the building works to begin in week 8 of this term
- Upgrading toilet facilities single use bathrooms to the oval
 - Removing the canteen toilets
 - I block turn into single use from the outside
- Uniform Survey
 - o 160 parent responses
 - o Jumper alternative option of a different fabric. Meeting with Lowes to look at samples.
- James presented a Library Proposal & Staffroom upgrades
 - Concept images were provided:
 - Library
 - Furnware \$42873.60 (\$38976 ex GST)
 - Raeco \$48351.34 this option is preferred
 - Staffroom Furniture updates
 - Furnware \$48491.16 (\$44082.87 ex gst)
 - Raeco \$44 882.77 (this was the preferred option)
 - School is requesting P&F to co-contribute 50% This works out to be about \$48351.34 approx.
 - This proposal is in place of the landscaping proposal that was presented at the last meeting
 - A motion was proposed but wasn't moved as a concern was raised over the use of P&F funds for the staffroom upgrades. Discussion was had on this and a different motion was made and agreed upon.

Motion: P&F will contribute \$45000 to the Library Refurbishment.
